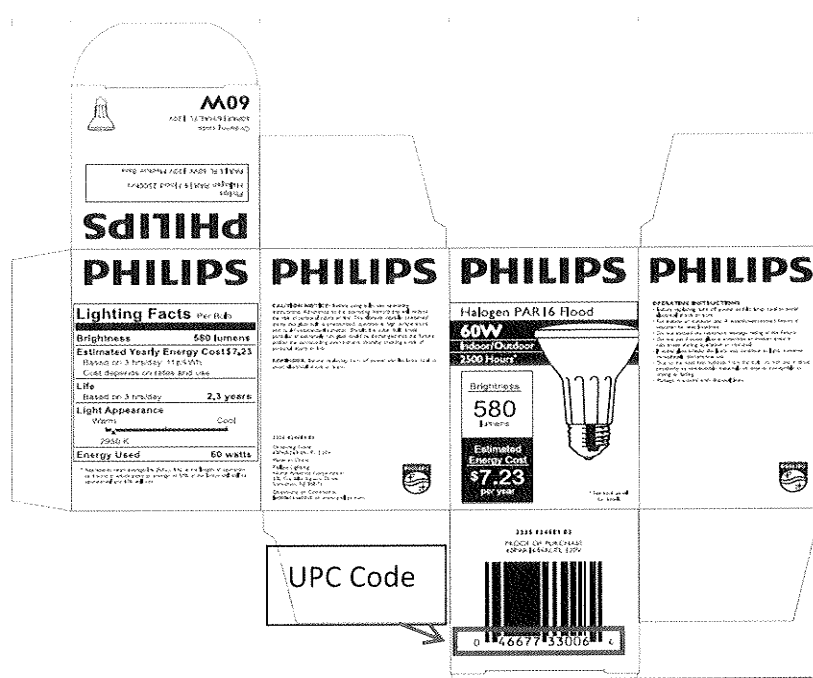
RE: Recall of Philips PAR16 60W, 120V halogen light bulbs

Dear Valued Customer:

Philips Lighting North America Corporation ("Philips") has announced a recall of its PAR16 60W, 120V halogen light bulbs manufactured and sold between November 2013 and March of 2015, primarily sold in retail outlets such as Home Depot and Amazon, as well as through professional distributors.

Specifically, the glass lens may shatter as a result of being exposed to the normal heat and pressure inside of these light bulbs, causing in pieces of glass falling from the ceiling. Additionally, the glue which attaches the glass lens to the body of the bulb can fail and cause the lens to fall and potentially shatter upon impact. Note also that the interior of the light bulb is hot, and thus, until the glass cools, the falling glass also presents a risk of burning. Accordingly, we have initiated a voluntary recall of the affected units in cooperation with the Consumer Product Safety Commission ("CPSC").

You should immediately discontinue use of any affected products and contact Philips for free replacements. In order to determine whether you have any affected product, you may consult either the package or the product itself. The affected product can be found in the following packages with UPC codes as indicated:

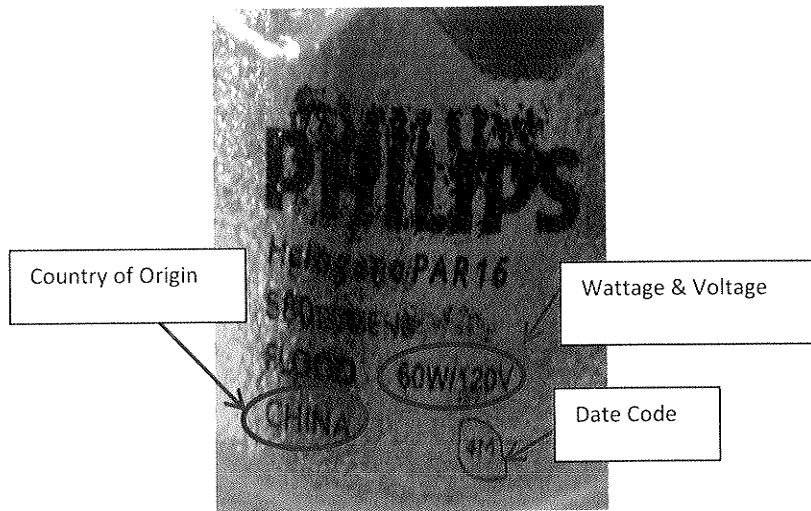
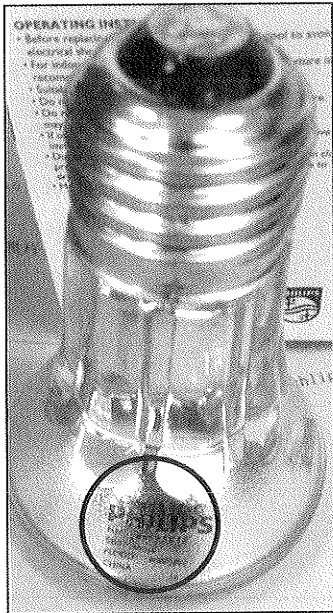

Only products with the above markings are within the scope of this recall. The country of origin, manufacturing date code, wattage, and voltage are etched on the product as follows:



To the extent that you have any affected units in your possession please immediately stop using the product. Turn off the light switch prior to unscrewing and removing the light bulb. Second, please contact Philips to take advantage of the recall in order to receive free replacement products. You can reach us by calling Philips Customer Care at 1-800-239-6587, Monday through Friday; from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm Eastern Time. You may also reach out to us anytime by emailing halogenlamp@philips.com.

Please note that you will need to return all affected product to Philips prior to receiving replacements. Philips has arranged for you to ship the affected units, at no cost, via Federal Express pre-paid shipping label. Once your affected units have been received, Philips will create a replacement order, free of charge and send free replacement products to you.

We ask that you contact Philips as soon as possible. You will be connected to an individual familiar with this issue who can answer questions and make arrangements for replacement products to be sent, all at no cost to you.
